Stylish award winning Champagne, well balanced with a creamy mousse and a long zesty finish. (Vegetarian)

19. Moet & Chandon Imperial Brut Champagne NV (France) £59.95  
Created in 1869, this is the iconic champagne of this producer. It has a bright fruitiness, and a seductive palate.

<b>1. Borsao Blanco (Spain)</b>	£5.95	£14.95
Spain now has very modern and innovative wine production. This wine is fruity, fresh and easy drinking with aromas of citrus and tropical fruits. The grape variety is Macabeo.		
<b>2. Pinot Grigio “Terrazze Della Luna” (Italy)</b>	£6.50	£17.95
An award winning dry wine, with delicate stone fruit and apple flavours and a floral nose. Sourced from the best hillside vineyard sites in the Valle dell’Adige. (Vegan)		
<b>3. Soul Tree Sauvignon Blanc (India)</b>	£6.95	£18.95
Vibrant, fresh and dry Sauvignon, with pear and elderflower aromas, hints of gooseberry and a smooth finish		
<b>4. Seriti Chenin Blanc (South Africa)</b>		£16.95
Fresh, dry and delicate wine, which is grown on bush vines in the Paarl area in the Western Cape. Showing citrus and baked apple aromas and gentle acidity. (Vegan)		
<b>5. Stone’s Throw Chardonnay (Australia)</b>		£19.95
Refreshingly unoaked wine showing citrus and white fruit flavours, grapefruit aromas and a bright finish. (Vegetarian)		
<b>6. Pouilly Fume, Domaine de Petit Soumard (France)</b>		£29.95
Ripe with grassy and mineral aromas. The taste of herbs and pink gooseberries compliments the long finish. (Vegan)		
<b>7. Chablis Domaine des Malandes (France)</b>		£31.95
From one of the best producers in Chablis, this wine is delicate yet powerful and has subtle mineral flavours. The wine will support more spicy curries, but will be ideal with most dishes as well. (Vegan)

A dry, delicate pink wine with red berry and strawberry aromas and summer fruit flavours.

# RED WINES

	250ml Glass	Bottle
<b>9. Borsao Tinto Garnacha (Spain)</b>	£5.95	£14.95
Full-bodied soft fruity red wine with aromas of red berries and floral notes and gentle tannins. Made from the Garnacha grape.		
<b>10. Pacifico Sur Merlot (Chile)</b>	£6.50	£17.95
Well balanced fruity wine with plummy fruit flavours typical of Merlot from this part of the world. No oak ageing. Perfect with medium spicy dishes.		
<b>11. Malbec Bodegas Septima (Argentina)</b>	£6.95	£18.95
Probably one of the best Malbecs we have tasted. On the nose there are aromas of plums, figs and vanilla from the careful use of oak ageing. The wine is full, with a long finish and a delicate flavour of sweet black berries. Will work with spicy and hotter curries.		
<b>12. The Opportunist Shiraz (Australia)</b>		£19.95
Sourced from vines in the historic Langhorne Creek region, this is a great example of good Aussie Shiraz. Aromas of ripe red fruits, ground coffee and hints of pepper. Aged in oak for only eight months to give a full, rich and a well balanced fruit taste. This wine can be drunk with the medium and hotter dishes. (Vegan)		
<b>13. Pinot Noir “Le Fou” (France)</b>		£21.95
Le Fou translates as Madman. Named because the growers were told that only madmen would grow Pinot Noir in the South of France. How wrong they were! Good fruit, tasty tannins and flavours of cooked cherries.		
<b>14. Rioja Crianza Bodegas Luis Canas (Spain)</b>		£24.95
This is what Rioja should taste like with enough oak ageing to give hints of licquorice, plum and cherry and red fruits. Ruby red coloured wine, with smooth tannins and a long finish. Ideal with the more powerful dishes. (Vegan)		
<b>15. Chateauneuf-du-Pape Domaine Chante Cigale (France)</b>		£39.95
Silky smooth wine with lots of warm red and black fruits, good tannins and an elegant finish. (Vegan)
